Uniform Guidelines

- Winter uniform is to be worn in Terms 2 and 3 of the school year. The outer garments must be the blazer when traveling to and from the College.
- Summer uniform is to be worn in Term 1 and 4 along with the College straw hat to be worn when travelling to and from the College. If an outer layer is required when travelling to and from the College, then this must be the College blazer, jumpers may be worn as an outer garment whilst at school.

PE Uniform (or specific sports uniform) must be worn in PE lessons and to all training and games. No other hoodie, tracksuit top or outer garment is to be worn with the PE/sports uniform.

General Guidelines

College blazers are to be worn to and from the College every day when wearing the Winter uniform. When wearing the summer uniform, blazers are required when travelling to and from school if an outer layer is required due to weather, on days when students attend Chapel, Mass or Senior School Assembly or as directed on special occasions. Students are expected to wear their full College uniform (winter or summer) when traveling to and from the College.

In Senior School, if students have PE or sports training that day, they will bring their sport's uniform in a sport's bag and change into it and then change back to full uniform to travel home at the end of the day. For instances of before school sport training, girls can wear their sport uniform to school but must change into their full Summer or Winter uniform before the commencement of the school day. Junior School students may wear their PE uniform to and from school on the days they participate in PE lessons or sport trainings.

In Junior School, students are to wear the College Straw Hat to and from the College in Terms 1 and 4. The College broad brimmed sun hat is to be worn during recess, lunch and physical education lessons in Terms 1 and 4 and also when the UV level reaches 3 and above (the Sports cap is only to be worn during co-curricular sporting activities).

PE uniforms only (or specific sports uniforms) are to be worn to all PE lessons, training and sporting games when representing Loreto College without any other garment underneath or over the top including no hoodies, unless a school issued hoodie. House Polo shirts are worn at swimming and athletics carnivals as well as other designated College House events.

College jumpers, including the Year 12 white jumper, are not outer garments to wear with the College uniform when coming to or going from the College and they may only be worn while at the College or underneath the College Blazer when inside or outside of the College.

College Straw Hats (or Sports caps if in sports uniform) are to be worn outside throughout Terms 1 and 4. This includes recess, lunch, physical education lessons and after-college play. Outdoor co-curricular activities also require students to wear a College hat to suit the sport or activity.

College bags and sports bags must be purchased from the uniform shop and feature the College crest.

Ribbons must be worn every day with the College uniform – white in summer and blue in winter. In winter, students from R-11 can wear a saxe blue scarf, while Year 12 students wear a cream scarf.

College shorts can be worn instead of the winter tunic or summer dress. In summer, shorts are worn with Loreto white short sleeved summer shirt and Loreto white short summer socks. In winter, shorts are worn with the long sleeved winter shirt and Loreto long saxe blue socks or saxe blue tights or stockings. Same rules for blazer and jumper applies. Long pants are available for winter for Senior School students and can be orderd from the Uniform Shop (sample sizes are available in store to try on).

Winter Uniform for Girls R-12

This uniform may be worn in Terms 2 and 3 of each year.

- College blazer
- College tunic or College shorts
- College long sleeved shirt
- College winter long saxe blue socks, knee-high or saxe blue tights or stockings
- College saxe blue ribbon (for winter)
- College jumper (optional)
- College scarf (optional) saxe blue for R-11 and cream for Year 12
- College vest (optional)



Summer Uniform for Girls R-12

This uniform may be worn for Terms 1 and 4 of each year.

- College summer dress or College shorts
- College blazer
- College short sleeved shirt (if wearing shorts)
- College straw hat
- College jumper (optional)
- College summer socks
- College white ribbon (for summer)
- Plain black lace-up, solid college shoe no sneakers or canvas shoes allowed



All Girls' Uniforms - Length of Winter Tunic and Summer Dress

The winter tunic, summer dress and shorts must be below the knee.



PE Uniform for All Students

- College sports polo short sleeved
- College sports shorts
- College rugby top or track jacket
- College sports socks
- College sports bag with crest
- House polo shirt
- College sports hat or cap (choice of sun-safe approved styles) compulsory during Terms 1 and 4 for all PE lessons and training
- Long or short bike pants (optional)
- College tracksuit pants (optional)
- Sport shoes with non-marking soles

For particular sports, there are dedicated uniforms including for netball, rowing, waterpolo, touch football and basketball. For all other sports the PE Uniform is to be worn as outlined above. Additional items are available at the uniform shop as outlined in the price list, however, are not compulsory for the uniform.



Jewellery

When in College uniform girls are permitted to wear one matching pair of plain gold or silver studs or sleepers in the ear lobes only. No nose piercings or other visible piercings are permitted, including clear nose studs. Multiple studs and large or ornate earrings are not permitted. Studs or sleepers are not to be worn with any sports uniform. A necklace with a crucifix or other religious or cultural symbol is permitted. No other visible jewellery is permitted.

Body piercings, tattoos or henna tattoos must not be seen when wearing any College uniform, including sports uniform. This rule also applies on Casual Clothes/Dress Up Days.

College Lapel badges can be worn when they are received at College Award Ceremonies.

Hair and Grooming

Hair for all students must be clean, neat and tidy at all times. Cuts or styles which, in the opinion of the College, are extreme and attract undue attention, are not acceptable. If in doubt consult the College before making radical changes to hair.

Hair may be coloured or dyed on the following two conditions:

- 1. The colour must be natural hair colour.
- 2. The hair must be one colour only.

All hair longer than shoulder length must be tied back. College ribbons must be worn when hair is tied back.

Visible make-up of any sort is not permitted. Visible eyelashes are also not permitted.

Casual/Dress Up Days

On days designated 'Casual/Dress Up Days', the guidelines for clothes are as follows:

- Appropriate, comfortable, and neat clothes required for activities on a usual school day that provide for appropriate participation in school lessons. Mid-rift tops are not permitted. If PE or sports training falls on a casual day, appropriate sports attire and sneakers are to be worn.
- Shirts with offensive (in the opinion of the College) text or images may not be worn
- All footwear must be enclosed with no thongs, sandals, ugg boots or slippers
- No visible make up
- Normal hair regulations
